Route related comments.

### Route related comments (1/2).



- The itinerary of the Grand Tour of Switzerland was originally designed for cars and motorcycles
  → larger vehicles should expect restrictions in 18 areas (details as per the following pages).
- Route can be travelled in both directions → recommended in clockwise direction (important to note in cities and motorway access).
- <u>Disclaimer</u>: The Grand Tour is a recommended route on Switzerland's current road network. The route is used at the traveller's own risk. Switzerland Tourism and the Association Grand Tour of Switzerland accept no liability for changes caused by reconstruction, for detours, signage, special events, and safety regulations along the route.
- Motorways only when preferable in terms of traffic and route → a motorway tax sticker is required for cars (CHF 40.00 / ca. € 34.00).
- Lump-sum heavy vehicle charge (PSVA) for Swiss vehicles: in Switzerland, a performance-related heavy vehicle charge is payable for transport motor vehicles and trailers with a total weight of over 3.5 tons each.

## Route related comments (2/2).



- Route leads across five mountain passes higher than 2000 m a.s.l. Alternatives:
  - → Flüela: Vereina car transport services from Davos-Selfranga to Sagliains
  - $\rightarrow$  Julier: road across the pass is open year-round
  - $\rightarrow$  San Bernardino: road tunnel between Hinterrhein and San Bernardino
  - → Gotthard: new road across the pass; road tunnel between Airolo and Göschenen
  - $\rightarrow$  Furka: car transport services from Realp to Oberwald
- Crossing Lake Lucerne by car ferry from Gersau to Beckenried (April October)
  → Alternative: drive directly from Gersau to Brunnen









- height: max. 3.30 m
- width: max. 2.50 m
- weight: max. 18 t
- length: 18.50 m

#### b) Car/coach transport service conditions: wagons <u>without</u> roof protection


- height: max. 4 m

- length: 12.50 m wheelbase












### **10.1 Airolo – Andermatt (TI / UR).** (Gotthard - new mountain pass)










### 10.2 Airolo – Andermatt (TI / UR). (Gotthard Road Tunnel)






## New Gotthard mountain pass is driveable for coaches
